HIGHLAND TELEPHONE COOPERATIVE, INC.'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INFORMATION

Highland Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Highland") hereby moves for an extension of time to file the information requested by the Commission Staff's Second Request for Information dated April 22, 2011 (the "Request"). Specifically, Highland requests an additional 20 days to complete its preparation and filing of the requested information.

The reason for needing the additional time is that Highland is a small rural cooperative with a limited staff, and the individuals who are gathering the information must at the same time perform the regular duties of their positions. Also, some of the individuals involved in gathering the information, including employees and professional advisers, had previously scheduled vacations during this time period. As a result, they were unable to collect the information or work on the responses within the time frame set forth in the Request. After the information has been collected, the responses must be drafted and then reviewed by Highland's management and advisers. Based on the schedules of these individuals, Highland estimates an additional 20 days are needed to complete and file the requested information.
