Re: <u>Boone County Water District</u> Purchased Water Adjustment

Dear Mr. Derouen:

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:068 and all applicable law, the Boone County Water District is hereby providing required documentation for a purchased water adjustment. Enclosed you will find the following:

- 1) Purchased water adjustment form;
- 2) Letter from the Boone-Florence Water Commission, supplier to the Boone County Water District, notifying of an increase in wholesale water rates;
- 3) Revised tariff sheets relating to rates and charges for the Boone County Water District reflecting the proposed purchased water adjustment.

Please note that "tank wagon sales" has been increased by \$.28 per 1,000 gallons from \$3.60 per 1,000 gallons to \$3.88 per 1,000 gallons, rather than the \$.26 provided for by the purchased water adjustment calculations. Water haulers purchase tokens in increments of 250 gallons per token. Water haulers can purchase any quantity of tokens. It is best that the rate for 1,000 gallons be divisible by four for "tank wagon sales" so that neither the District nor water haulers need to deal with one-half cent calculations.

Also enclosed is revised tariff for the Boone County Fiscal Court/Rural Water System. The Boone County Fiscal Court's Rural Water System is operated and maintained by the Boone County Water District pursuant to an operation and maintenance agreement and will be transferred to the Boone County Water District
