## ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:070, the Kentucky-Tennessee Section of the American Water Works Association ("KY-TN Section") has applied for accreditation and approval of its "2010 Kentucky/Tennessee Water Professionals Conference" conducted on July 18-21, 2010. This conference included instruction on water treatment and distribution system operations, capital planning, and water quality law.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." Having reviewed KY-TN Section's application, the Commission finds that the proposed presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 12.0 hours of water district management training.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The KY-TN Section's presentation "Drinking Water Update" is accredited and approved for a maximum of 12 credit hours of water district management training.
- 2. The KY-TN Section shall retain a record of all persons attending the accredited and approved presentation.
- 3. Within 14 days of the date of this Order, the KY-TN Section shall file with the Commission:
- a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;
- b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KY-TN Section's application; and
- c. The name of each water district commissioner who attended, the name of his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
