COOLBROOK UTILITIES, LLC'S ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO COMMISSION STAFF REPORT

Comes Coolbrook Utilities, LLC ("Coolbrook"), by counsel, and for its additional comments to the Commission Staff's Report, states as follows:

- Commission Staff should approve an Owner/Manager Fee of no less than \$6,000.00. As reflected in the attached affidavits of Lawrence W. Smither and Martin G. Cogan (Attachment A), these individuals have extensive in the operation, maintenance, design and construction of wastewater treatment plants, having combined experience in this field of over 70 years. The Coolbrook WWTP serves 435 customers and has an aging plant and collection system requiring substantial time and attention. A list of the additional repair items needed to recondition the WWTP, lift stations and sewer mains is attached as Attachment B.
- 2) The Owner/Managers of Coolbrook are responsible for:
 - the operation and management of the Coolbrook WWTP and collection system.
 - insuring proper maintenance, repairs and improvements to the plant and collection system.
 - preparing and submitting the required reports, applications for rate adjustment and tax returns to the Commission and the Revenue Department.
 - preparing and submitting the required reports to the Kentucky Division of Water, including the monthly discharge monitoring reports.
 - compliance by the Coolbrook WWTP with the regulations of both the Commission and the Kentucky Division of Water.
 - the owner/managers are subject to substantial potential liability arising out of the operation of the WWTP, including potential liability in the event that Coolbrook

has an upset and fails to comply with its KPDES permit or one of its customers experiences a backup of wastewater into his/her home. The applicable statutes authorize a fine of up to \$5,000 for discharges in violation of the KPDES permit.

- hiring and supervising the professionals retained by Coolbrook, including accountants and attorneys.
- hiring and supervising Coolbrook's part-time employee and its subcontractors.
- monitoring the billing and collection of Coolbrook's total revenue and payment of Coolbrook's total expenses.

This information establishes that the Commission should approve an Owner/Manager fee of at least \$6,000.00.

- The Commission should allow Coolbrook to recover the major non-routine expenditures incurred by Coolbrook since June of 2010 through depreciation over 8.5 years consistent with the Staff Report, a list of which is attached as Attachment C. The invoices for the March 1, 2011 expense to River City Controls and the March 9, 2011 expense to Quality Electric are included in Attachment B.
- The invoices reflecting the attorneys fees incurred to date by Coolbrook in this rate case will be submitted on Monday, April 4, 2011, as the most recent invoice will be issued on that date.

- That I have am one of the two members of Coolbrook Utilities, LLC and am involved in the management of the Coolbrook Wastewater Treatment Plant ("WWTP") on a weekly, if not daily, basis.
- That I have extensive experience in the operation, maintenance, design and construction of wastewater treatment plants. In fact, I have designed wastewater treatment plants, pumping stations, have assisted engineering firms in the design of sewer systems, supervised the installation of same and have reconstructed used wastewater treatment plants and pump stations.
- That I have been licensed by the Commonwealth of Kentucky as a wastewater treatment plant operator for over thirty-eight (38), and have operated package wastewater treatment plants and collection systems in Kentucky and other states for over thirty-eight (38) years. I currently oversee the operation and maintenance of over 15 wastewater treatment plants in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 4) For a period of about ten (10) years, from 1975 to 1985, I was directly responsible for the operation and maintenance of approximately 120 wastewater treatment plants throughout Kentucky and southern Indiana. When the Louisville and Jefferson County

List of additional repair items that are needed to recondition the treatment plant, lift stations and sewer mains:

1) Repair the main air header that serves both plant #1 and #2.

2) Fabricate and install a new main air header for plant #3.

- 3) Fabricate and install fifteen (15) new 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " black steel diffuser drops, complete with new diffusers, in plant #1 and #2. 4175.00
- 4) Fabricate and install ten (10) new 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " black steel diffuser drops, complete with new diffusers, in plant #3.
- 5) Fabricate and install twelve (12) new 1 ½" black steel diffuser drops, complete with new diffusers, in plant #4. 3700.00
- 6) Fabricate and install new 3" air lift scum returns in plant #2; #3; and #4. 5980.00
- 7) Remove the old wooden inlet baffles in all four (4) secondary clarifiers and replace with new ¼" plate steel baffles.

- 8) Purchase and install one (1) new standby blower/motor assembly for plant #1 and #2. It does currently have a standby blower but it is to small to aerate these two tanks if the primary blower were to fail.

- 9) Purchase and install one (1) new standby blower/motor assembly for plant #3. There currently is only one blower for this plant. 7075.00
- 10) Make repairs to the steel tankage in various places where the steel is in very bad condition or is rusted all the way through. 15,000.00 to 20,000.00



- 11) Purchase and install a new duplex pump control panel for the main sewage pumps at the treatment plant. 5420.00
- 12) Install a good used UV disinfection system at the treatment plant. (We already have the UV unit it was given to us) Engineering will also be necessary. Approx. 7500.00
- 13) Have a complete sewer survey performed on all sewer mains in the Coolbrook Utilities system. (TV and smoke testing)

 Approx. 75,000.00
- 14) Make the sewer repairs that are shown to be necessary in the sewer survey. It is impossible to put a price tag on this item without knowing the repairs that are needed.
