Pursuant to KRS 278.020 (1) and 807 KAR 5:069, Foothills Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc ("Foothills") submits the enclosed Verified Application ("Application") for authority and approval from the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the construction of new facilities and to upgrade of existing facilities in rural areas of Magoffin and Lawrence counties in the eastern region of Kentucky within its certified territory.

On March 26, 2010 Foothills submitted an application under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Broadband Initiatives Program ("ARRA") administered by the Rural Utility Service ("RUS") for grants and loans for the purpose of completing its Fiber to the Premises project.

On August 9, 2010, the RUS provided notification to Foothills that its' application had been approved for a loan/grant combination by the RUS under the ARRA. A copy of the RUS award letter is enclosed herein as well as attached to the enclosed Verified Application.

Foothills is required to have all necessary certifications in place or pending prior to receipt of ARRA funds.

Foothills is enclosing herein one original Application with attachments and ten copies of

Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. ("Foothills RTCC") respectively submits this

("Commission") and in support of its request hereby states:

<u>I.</u>

Foothills RTCC is a non-stock, non-profit membership cooperative corporation, duly

organized and existing under and by virtue of the provisions of KRS 279 and pursuant to 807

KAR 5:001: Section 9(1)(a) attaches a copy of Foothills RTCC' Articles of Incorporation and

any amendments collectively as Exhibit "1".

<u>II.</u>

Foothills RTCC's mailing address of its' headquarters office is:

Foothills RTCC hereby submits this disclosure in compliance with and pursuant to 807

KAR 5:001 Section 8(1).

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<u>III.</u>

Foothills RTCC is an authorized Rural Utilities Services ("RUS") borrower and operates a local telephone system containing seven (7) exchanges in eastern Kentucky. As of June 30, 2010, the Applicant had a total of 14,287 access lines providing telephone service to subscribers in parts of Magoffin, Johnson, Lawrence, and Breathitt Counties of eastern Kentucky.

<u>IV.</u>

On March 26, 2010 Foothills RTCC submitted an application under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Broadband Initiatives Program ("BIP") Round 2, administered by the Rural Utility Service ("RUS") for grants and loans in the amount of \$21,818,512 for the purposes of deploying Fiber-to-the-Premises ("FTTP") in the most rural parts of Magoffin and Lawrence Counties. RUS provided notification of approval of Foothills RTCC's application on August 6, 2010. A copy of the RUS "award letter" is attached hereto as Exhibit "3" ("RUS Award Letter"). The RUS' approval of Foothills RTCC's application consisted of a seventy percent (70%) grant in the amount of \$14,680,738, and a thirty percent (30%) loan in the amount of \$6,291,744. An additional \$864,030 will be used by Foothills RTCC from existing independent funding for this proposed project.

<u>V.</u>

The proposed project will pass 3,035 customer premises resulting in construction of approximately 390 route miles of telecommunication fiber. Once built and operating, these premises will be capable of receiving high quality high speed Internet, HD television service, and state of the art telecommunications services. The proposed project

will add to and nearly complete the availability of FTTP within Foothills RTCC's designated service area.

Gigabit Passive Optical Networking ("GPON") standards are planned to be used in implementing the FTTP technology. The implementation of GPON will require upgrades, additions, and replacements of central office equipment throughout the construction area. It will also require upgrades and additions in the main hub central offices that feed into these areas.

<u>VI.</u>

Foothills RTCC does not anticipate seeking any rate adjustments as a result of the construction expenditures associated with this proposed project with the approved RUS funding including a seventy percent (70%) grant in the amount of \$14,680,738.

<u>VII.</u>

Foothills RTCC does not require any additional franchise approval from any public authority for the proposed construction within the designated areas. Foothills RTCC makes this disclosure in conformity with 807 KAR 001 Section 9(2)(b).

<u>VIII.</u>

The Applicant does not anticipate that the proposed new construction will compete with any public utility, corporation, or persons providing telecommunications services within its service area. Limited competition may exist with cablevision providers within the service area.

<u>IX.</u>

The map depicting the areas of construction within the proposed project in accordance with 807 KAR 500:1; section 9(2)(d) is attached hereto in triplicate as
