Dear Mr. DeRouen:

Enclosed please find 1 set of project maps associated with the subject case. These maps represent the planned routes of the fiber optic cable which will be installed using federal funding from the ARRA. Also included is a CD with the maps in .pdf format which will allow the viewer to zoom in and out and provide better detail.

These fiber routes are overlaid onto USGS Quads that are scaled in such a manner to show the entirety of each project area -- one map for the North project area in Lawrence County and one map for the South project area in Magoffin County.

It should be noted that there are several sections of the project where the new fiber does not apparently connect to a central office or remote. That is because on earlier projects (mostly the RUS funded projects from 3-6 years ago) we had provided enough feeder and trunk fiber at the end points of those projects so that the remaining unserved areas could be served in the future. This new project splices onto those previously constructed fiber cables and continues the FTTP service on from that point.
