Attached for your review is an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction of fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) in the current operating areas of West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. (WK&T).

On August 4, 2010 WK&T was notified that the USDA Rural Utilities Service (RUS) had accepted an application filed by the Company on March 29, 2010 for a grant/loan award of \$123.8 million.
