Pursuant to the Commission's October 29, 2010 notice in the above-styled case, an informal conference ("IC") was held in this matter on November 9, 2010. A copy of the conference attendance list is attached. In addition to Commission Staff, representatives and counsel for Meade County RECC ("Meade County") and two representatives of Meade County's contractor, Bowlin Energy Services ("BES"), were in attendance.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss issues related to the show cause Order issued by the Commission on October 6, 2010. In its October 6, 2010 Order, the Commission alleged several violations of the National Electrical Safety Code ("NESC") stemming from an incident on August 12, 2009, in which a member of a BES construction crew was injured when he came into contact with a power line tensioner (or brake) that had accidentally become energized while the crew was working on a reconductoring project on Meade County's system.

As a result of discussions between Commission Staff and Meade County, a proposed settlement was verbally agreed to and will be memorialized in a stipulation of facts and settlement agreement.

Commission Staff will draft the proposed settlement agreement and will send it to Meade County's counsel for review. Once the settlement agreement is completed and signed, it will be sent to the Commission for review. If approved by the Commission, a final order will be issued stating that the Commission adopts the settlement agreement.
