Dear Mr. Moore:

The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Treatment you filed on April 20, 2011 on behalf of Windstream Kentucky West, LLC and Windstream Kentucky East, LLC, ("Windstream") to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential pursuant to Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.870. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as being contained in Windstream's Access Revenue Impact filing. The information is more particularly described as including expected amount of revenue shift under the AT&T plan, as well as revenue associated with their dedicated transport services.


Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the public disclosure of the information would compromise Windstream's competitive position in the industry, which would result in an unfair commercial advantage to its competitors.

Based on a review of the information and pursuant to KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, the Commission has determined that the information requested to be held confidential is of a proprietary nature, which if publicly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to Windstream's competitors. Therefore, the information requested to be treated as confidential **meets the criteria for confidential protection** and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 7(8) of 807 KAR 5:001.

If the information becomes publicly available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, Windstream Kentucky West, LLC and Windstream Kentucky East, LLC are required by Section 8(9)(a) of 807 KAR 5:001 to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
