
Our client, France Telecom Corporate Solutions L.L.C. ("FTCS"), is a CLEC authorized to provide services in Kentucky under Filing No. T 64-0081. FTCS operates on a "pure resale" basis, *i.e.*, it does not own or control any telecommunication facilities, and it does not purchase unbundled network elements.
