REQUEST:

Refer to the Answer and Motion to Dismiss ("Answer") filed on November 29, 2010, at paragraph 17. Duke Kentucky states that "... the higher bills it complains of are attributable in part to an increase in electric base rates (attributable to the roll-in of greater fuel adjustment clause expenses) which took effect in mid-2009 and an increase in natural gas rates which took effect in early 2010." Explain how a roll-in of fuel costs to base rates, with a corresponding decrease to the fuel adjustment clause, would affect

the total bill of a customer.

RESPONSE:

Per Commission order in Case No. 2008-00522, Duke Energy Kentucky increased its electric base rates due to the increase in the base fuel component effective with the first billing cycle for July 2009. Beginning with the expense month for July 2009, Duke Energy Kentucky calculated a Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) rate based upon the

increased base fuel rate.

The FAC filing is based on a two month lag of actual expenses; therefore the expense month of July impacts September FAC rates. Due to the two month lag, the July and August base fuel rate in base rates and the FAC rate are not the same. Duke Energy Kentucky worked with the Staff on the implementation of the change of the base fuel rate

in base rates and the calculation of the FAC rates.

The Complainant's meter tested three one

hundredths of one percent (0.03%) slow.
