NOTICE

Hillridge Facilities, Inc. ("Hillridge"), filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission proposing to increase its monthly sewer rate from \$24.13 to \$32.50, an increase of 34.7%. Hillridge also requested authority to assess a surcharge of \$11.19 per month for 36 months to pay for repairs to its sewer collection mains. This application has been docketed as PSC Case No. 2010-00426. Hillridge believes it could justify a rate increase of 55.6% based upon its operating costs, but requested the lower rate increase to reduce the burden upon its customers. Hillridge has now withdrawn its request for surcharge, and amended its application to propose to increase its monthly sewer rate to \$36.52.
