AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GRAYSON RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

Thefore L Secure Pursuant to Section 279.050 and other applicable sections of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, the undereigned corporation adepts the fellowing amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

, The name of the corporation is Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation.

(2)

The fellowing Amondment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted unenimously by the Beard of Directors of the Corporation and the members thereof by a majority of said members at a meeting held July 16, 1975, and in the menner required by the laws of the State of Kentucky, to-wit:

Article II of the original Articles of Incorporation is emended to read an follown:

ARTICLE II.

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is formed are to premete and encourage the fullest possible use of electric onergy in the Commonwealth of Kentucky by making electric energy avallable by production, transmission or distribution, or both, to or by otherwise securing the same for the inhabitants of and persons in areas of the Commonwealth of Kentucky at the levent cost consistent with sound business matheds and prudent management of the business of the Corporation and also by making available to the said inhabitants and persons electrical devices, equipment, wiring applicantes, fixtures and supplies and all kinds of tools, equipment and machinery (including any fixtures or property or both which may by its une be conducted to a more complete use of electricity or electric energy) operated by electricity or electric energy and, without limiting the generality of the ferensings

- (a) to generate, manufacture, purchase, acquire and accumulate electric energy for its members and non-members to the extent permitted by the Act under which the Corporation is fermed and to transmit, distribute, furnish, sell and dispose of such electric energy to its members and non-members to the extent permitted by the Act under which the Corporation is fermed, and to construct, exect, purchase, lease as lessee and in any manner acquire, own, hold, maintain, operate, sell, dispose of, lease as lesser, exchange and mertgage plants, buildings, works, machinery, supplies, apparatus, equipment and electric transmission and distribution lines or systems necessary, convenient or use-ful for carrying out and accomplishing any or all of the foregoing purposes;
- (b) to acquire, own, hold, use, exercise and, to the extent permitted by law, to soll, mertgege, pledge, hypethecote and in any seamer dispose of franchises, rights, privileges, licenses, rights of way and casements necessary, useful or apprepriate to accomplish any or all of the purposes of the Corporation;
- (c) to purchase, receive, lease as lessee, or in any other menner acquire, out, hold, maintain, use, convey, sell, lease as lesser, exchange, mertgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of any and all real and personal property or any interest therein accessary, useful or appropriate to enable the Corporation to accomplish any or all of its purposes;

- (d) to easist its members to wire their premises and install therein electrical and plumbing appliances, fixtures, machinery, supplies, apperatus and squirment of any and all kinds and character (including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, such as are applicable to water amply and somage disposal) and, in connection therewith and for such purposes, to purchase, acquire, leace, cell, distribute, install and repair electrical and plumbing appliances, fixtures, machinery, supplies, apparatus and equipment of any and all kinds and character (including, without Limiting the generality of the foregoing, such as ere applicable to water supply and sewage disposal) and to receive, acquire, enderse, plodge, guarantee, hypothecate, transfer or otherwise dispose of notes and other evidences of indebtedness and all security thorofors
- (e) to berrow money, to make and leave bands, nates and
