The City of Nicholasville's Combined Utilities System has filed a three-tiered phase-in proposed rate schedule to increase the rate for wholesale water service as set forth below:

The proposed effective date is October 4, 2008 for phase one to be reflected on bills due in November 2008, an effective date of June 1, 2009 for phase two to be reflected on bills due in July 2009, and an effective date of June 1, 2010 for phase three to be reflected on bills due in July 2010.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the City of Nicholasville's Combined Utilities System. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates in this notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.
