This Application of the Rattlesnake Ridge Water District ("Applicant") respectfully shows:

- 1. That Applicant is a water district created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
 - 2. That the post office address of Applicant is:

- 3. That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.020 and 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity permitting Applicant to construct a waterworks construction project as defined below (the "Project"); (ii) an Order approving increased rates and charges; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.
- 4. The project consists of the (i) expansion of the water treatment plant from 1.608 MGD to 2.408 MGD; (ii) construction of a 500,000 gallon elevated water storage tank; and (iii) installation of a transmission line that will connect to the main lines at State Route 7 and feed the proposed 500,000 gallon elevated water storage tank.
- 5. That the District is financing of the construction of the Project through (i) the issuance of \$2,482,000 of its Waterworks Revenue Bonds, consisting of \$1,336,000 of Series A Bonds and \$1,146,000 of Series B Bonds; (ii) a USDA, Rural Development ("RD") grant in the amount of \$1,100,000; (iii) a Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") in the amount of \$1,000,000; (iv) an Appalachian Regional Commission ("ARC") grant in the amount of \$400,000; (v) an Infrastructure for Economic Development Fund ("IEDF") 2008 grant (Lawrence County) in the amount of \$500,000; (vi) an IDEF 2008 grant (Elliott County) in the amount of \$500,000; and
