\$.024 per 1,000 gallons per month, applicable to residential, commercial, and industrial customers, from the effective date of the tariff, will be charged in order to eliminate the arrearage to the Municipal Bond Commission.

\$0.10 per 1,000 gallons per month, applicable to all resale customers, from the effective date of the tariff will be charged in order to eliminate the arrearage to the Municipal Bond Commission.


