AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GRAYSON RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

Refine L. House Pursuant to Section 279.050 and other applicable sections of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, the undereigned corporation adopts the following amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

, The name of the corporation is Grayson Rural Slectric Comperative Corporation.

(2)

The fellowing Amondment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted unenimously by the Beard of Directors of the Corporation and the members thereof by a majority of said members at a meeting held July 16, 1975, and in the manner required by the laws of the State of Kentucky, to-wit:

Article II of the original Articles of Incorporation is emended to read as follows:

### ARTICLE II.

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is formed ero to premote and encourage the fullest possible use of electric energy in the Commonwealth of Kentucky by making electric energy available by production, transmission or distribution, or both, to or by otherwise securing the same for the inhabitants of end persons in areas of the Commonwealth of Kontucky at the levent cost consistent with sound business motheds and prudent management of the business of the Corporation and also by making available to the said inhabitants and persons electrical devices, equipment, wiring applicantes, fixtures and supplies and all kinds of tools, equipment and machinery (including any fixtures or property or both which may by its use be conducive to a more complete use of electricity or electric energy) operated by electricity or electric energy and, without limiting the generality of the ferensings

- (a) to generate, manufacture, purchase, acquire and accumulate electric energy for its members and non-members to the extent permitted by the Act under which the Corporation is fermed and to transmit, distribute, furnish, sell and dispose of such electric energy to its members and non-members to the extent permitted by the Act under which the Corporation is fermed, and to construct, erect, purchase, lease as lessee and in any manner acquire, own, hold, maintain, eperate, sell, dispose of, lease as lesser, exchange and mertgage plants, buildings, works, machinery, supplies, apparatus, equipment and electric transmission and distribution lines or systems necessary, convenient or use-ful for carrying out and accomplishing any or all of the foregoing purposes;
- (b) to acquire, own, hold, use, exercise and, to the extent permitted by law, to coll, mertgere, pledge, hypothecate and in any manner dispose of franchises, rights, privileges, licenses, rights of way and capements necessary, useful or appropriate to accomplish any or all of the purposes of the Corporation;
- (c) to purchase, receive, lease as lessee, or in any other menner acquire, own, held, maintain, use, cenvey, well, lease as lesser, exchange, mertgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of any and all real and personal property or any interest therein necessary, useful or appropriate to enable the Corporation to accomplish any or all of its purposes:

- (d) to eaclot its mosbers to wire their promises and install therein electrical and plumbing appliances, fixtures, mechinery, supplies, apperatus and equipment of any and all kinds and character (including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, such as are applicable to water supply and somage disposal) and, in connection therewith and for such purposes, to purchase, acquire, leace, cell, distribute, install and repair electrical and plumbing appliances, fixtures, machinery, supplies, apparatus and equipment of eny end all kinds and character (including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, such as are applicable to water sumply and sewage disposal) end to receive, acquire, enderse, pledge, guarantee, hypothecate, transfer or etherwise dispose of notes and other evidences of indebtedness and all security therefore
- (b) to berrow money, to make end issue bands, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, secured or imsecured, for moneys berrowed or in payment for property sequired, or for any of the other objects or purposes of the Corporation; to accure the payment of such bands, notes or other evidences of indebtedness by martgage or mortgages, or deed or deeds of trust upon, or by the pledge of or other lien upon, any or all of the property, rights, privileges or permits of the Corporation, whereseever situated, acquired or to be acquired;

(f) to do and perform, either for itself or its members, any and all acts and things, and to have and exercise any and all powers, as may be necessary or convenient to accomplish any or all of the foregoing purposes or as may be permitted by the Act under which the Corporation is formed, and to exercise any of its powers anywhere.
