Dear Mr. Nuckols:

On January 30, 2012 Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation ("Jackson Purchase") filed a report with the Commission regarding its efforts to refund monies collected in excess of the rates that were approved in Case No. 2011-00038. On February 21, 2012 Jackson Purchase provided supplemental information requested by Commission Staff in a February 10, 2012 letter. As requested, Jackson Purchase provided the amount of customer charge billing determinants, kWh, and kW billed during the refund period by rate class. However, in order to properly review Jackson Purchase's January 30, 2012 report, Commission Staff requests that the following information be provided:

1. The amount of customer charge billing determinants, kWh, and kW billed during the refund period for each billing cycle by rate class.

2. Jackson Purchase's February 21, 2012 filing shows that the amount it refunded to "Rural" customers was based on a total of 109,582,075 kWh (both light and meter kWh). A January 30, 2012 filing by Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") in Case No. 2011-00036 shows that its refund to Jackson Purchase was based on a total of 91,986,690 kWh (both September and October 2011) for the Jackson Purchase "Rural" customers. Explain the circumstances that would cause the amount refunded by Jackson Purchase to be based on almost 20 percent more kWh than the amount refunded to Jackson Purchase from Big Rivers.
