## Dear Counselors:

The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Treatment you filed on February 3, 2012 on behalf of Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (the "Companies") to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential pursuant to Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.870. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as being contained in Exhibits and Appendix to David Sinclair Rebuttal Testimony. The information is described as re-dacted portions of Exhibits DSS-2, DSS-4, DSS-9, containing fuel price forecasts; re-dacted portions of Exhibits DSS-2, DSS-4, DSS-7, and DSS-9 containing information from "RFP"; and Appendix C in its entirety, containing a report purchased from HIS CERA, which is subject to copyright laws. The information requested to be treated as confidential is contain on a CD.

Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the public disclosure of the information could result in an unfair commercial advantage to the Companies competitors; and the copyrighted information is barred from disclosure via copyright laws and regulations.



Based on a review of the information and pursuant to KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, the Commission has determined that the information requested to be held confidential is of a proprietary nature, which if publicly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to LG&E's and KU's competitors; and disclosure of copyrighted materials is in violations of laws and regulations governing copyrighted materials. Therefore, the information requested to be treated as confidential **meets the criteria for confidential protection** and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 7(8) of 807 KAR 5:001.

If the information becomes publicly available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company are required by Section 8(9)(a) of 807 KAR 5:001 to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
