**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND  
JANUARY 27, 2012 PETITION FOR  
CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) moves the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(5) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7 for leave to amend its January 27, 2012 petition for confidential treatment.

1. In its January 27, 2012 petition for confidential treatment Kentucky Power sought confidential treatment for all material on the CD filed in connection with its response to Sierra Club 1-5.

2. The Company has determined that public disclosure of certain portions of the material contained on the CD provided in connection with the Company’s response to Sierra Club 1-5 will not result in competitive injury to Kentucky Power. Accordingly, Kentucky Power seeks leave to amend its motion to seek confidential treatment for only that portion of its response that meets the requirements of KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.

3. Filed with this Motion for Leave to Amend is a CD containing those portions of the response to Sierra Club 1-5 for which the Company is seeking confidential treatment. Ten revised redacted copies of the Company response to Sierra Club 1-5 also are filed with this motion.

4. Disclosure of those portions of Kentucky Power's response to Sierra Club 1-5 for which the Company is seeking confidential treatment would result in competitive injury to Kentucky Power. The confidential portions of the Company's response to Sierra Club 1-5 are entitled to protection for the reasons set forth in Kentucky Power's January 27, 2012 Petition for Confidential Treatment.

5. Kentucky Power restates and reincorporates its January 27, 2012 Petition for Confidential Treatment with respect to



Wherefore, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests the Commission to enter an Order:

1. Granting Kentucky Power leave to amend its January 27, 2012 Petition for Confidential Treatment;
2. Granting confidential treatment for the matters set forth in the January 27, 2012 Petition, as amended as set forth herein with respect to the Company's response to Sierra Club 1-5; and
3. Granting Kentucky Power all further relief to which it may be entitled.
