
ORDER

On June 21, 2013, the Commission entered an Order approving, in part, certain non-recurring charges. Our Order in this case contained an inadvertent error.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, to be entered *nunc pro tunc*, that the fifth sentence of the first full paragraph on page 3 of the Commission's June 21, 2013 Order, is amended to read as follows:

The Commission further finds that a meter test fee should only be charged to a customer pressing for an immediate test if the meter test shows that the meter is within the limits established by 807 KAR 5:022, Section 8(3)(a)1, so that customers are not penalized for reporting meters that are registering inaccurately.
