1OTION TO DISN PROCEEDIN

Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") respectfully moves the Public Service Commission to enter an order dismissing this proceeding without prejudice to Delta's right to seek to revise its Gas Cost Recovery ("GCR") tariff in the future. In support of the foregoing motion, Delta states that it has responded to two sets of the Commission Staffs requests for information and participated in two informal conferences with the Commission Staff in this proceeding. As a result of the information exchange and the informal conferences, Delta and the Staff are in agreement that a prudent course of action would be for Delta to implement changes in the calculation of its Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") under its existing GCR tariff and monitor the results to determine if such changes will alleviate Delta's under-recoveries of gas costs without the immediate need for changing its GCR tariff to provide for the collection or refund of carrying costs associated with under- or over-recoveries,
