Joint Motion For Informal Conference

Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Brandenburg Telephone
Company, Inc., Duo County Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Foothills Rural
Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Gearheart Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a

Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Peoples Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc.

Company, Inc., West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation., Inc. d/b/a WK&T,
South Central Telcom LLC, Cumberland Cellular, Inc., d/b/a Duo County Telecom, North
Central Communications, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Kentucky ("AT&T

Kentucky"), and AT&T Corp. (collectively the "Movants") jointly move the Public Service Commission of Kentucky pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4) for an informal conference to permit the Movants to address any questions Staff may have, and to provide further information requested by Staff, concerning the Settlement Agreement reached by the Movants in the above-styled matters. The Settlement Agreement was tendered to the Commission as EXHIBIT 1 to the Movants' October 10, 2014 "Joint Motion to Approve Settlement Agreement and to Dismiss Actions With Prejudice as Settled" that was filed concurrently with this motion. In support of their Joint Motion the Movants state:

- 1. On October 9, 2014 the Movants entered into a Settlement Agreement that, *inter alia*, settles five actions¹ currently pending before the Commission. Concurrently with this motion, the Movants are requesting that the Commission approve the Settlement Agreement without modification, and dismiss the five actions on or before November 1, 2014.
- 2. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4), provides that upon motion by any party the Commission "may convene a conference in a case for the purpose of considering the possibility of settlement, the simplification or clarification of issues, or any other matter that may aid in the handling and disposition of the case."
- 3. The requested settlement conference will enable the parties to address any questions Staff may have concerning the meaning or effect of the Settlement Agreement's terms, and to clarify and simplify any issues regarding the Settlement Agreement and the requested relief.

4. Consistent with the procedure followed by the Commission in Case No. 10064,² all discussions should be treated as confidential and not introduced in evidence in any proceeding. Further, as provided for by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4), attendance at the informal conference should be limited to the parties³ and their representatives.

WHEREFORE, the Movants respectfully and jointly request that the Public Service Commission of Kentucky enter an Order:

- (a) Scheduling an informal conference at the Commission's earliest convenience and within a time frame sufficient to permit consideration of the Settlement Agreement on or before November 1, 2014; and
 - (b) Granting the Movants all further relief to which they may appear entitled.
