





**Request 1.**           Refer to EKPC's response to Request 7, pages 19 to 23, filed with the Commission on September 13, 2011. The Green Valley Landfill has numerous fuel outages. Provide an update on the status of the operations of the Green Valley Landfill since the time of this response.

**Response 1.**           During the period under review, Green Valley produced 5,751 megawatt hours of net generation. From May 1, 2011 to September 30, 2011, the net generation produced was 6,906 megawatt hours. The operation has seen a favorable increase in performance.

**Request 2.** Refer to EKPC's response to Request 9, page 2 of 2, filed with the Commission on September 13, 2011. Which of the utilities listed have coal purchases with a similar coal quality profile to that of EKPC?

**Response 2.** After reviewing as much information as is available, the utility that purchases the most similar coal quality to EKPC is Kentucky Utilities. However, EKPC purchases more low sulfur coal than does Kentucky Utilities.
