

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-08-09
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORD. NO. 08-03-2009 A ; ESTABLISHING
NEW DRIVEWAY TILE DIMENSIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Eddyville, Kentucky desires to amend its ordinance relating to driveway tile dimensions as evidenced by Ord 08-03-2009 A, to better promote the public, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Eddyville, Kentucky; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Eddyville, Kentucky that Ord. 08-03-2009 A, relating to driveway tile dimensions is Hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 150.06 (A)(3)(a)-shall be amended to read in its entirety:

Driveway tile shall be a minimum of 15-inch diameter corrugated steel with a minimum length of 22 feet, subject to approval by the Eddyville Street Department: [Driveway tiles will have no minimum diameter, but must be corrugated steel. The size of the tile shall be determined by a representative from the City of Eddyville, Kentucky, when a building permit is issued.

The tile shall have a minimum length of 22 feet, unless property circumstances prevent, subject to approval by a representative from the City of Eddyville. In some instances, no tile will be required if there is no ditch and water will not flow onto the street.]

The modifications to the ordinance relating to the driveway tile dimensions are hereby adopted and incorporated by the reference herein, the same as if copied at length herein. This ordinance is effective upon its passage and publication. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or a portion of this ordinance is declared illegal, unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions hereof

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby amended





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## Spurrier hopes QB change improves offense vs.

COLUMBIA, S.C. - Steve Spurrier isn't happy with No. 18 South Carolina's stumbling offense, so he's benching quarterback Stephen Garcia and inserting sophomore Connor Shaw back in the starting lineup.

The Gamecocks coach isn't sure what to do beyond that.

"That's where we are on offense," Spurrier said Tuesday.

He added the team's needs to get more players involved and that the offensive line needs to step up.

Spurrier said the offensive line must block better, give whoever is playing quarterback more time to throw and to open up holes for running backs. The only change up front is likely to be Mike Matulis subbing at left tackle for Kyle Nunn, who continues to be out with a back injury.

The coach would like to get more players involved in the backfield and at receiver. So far, that hasn't happened.

"We sort of got stuck playing the same guys about the whole game," Spurrier said. "Hopefully, we can get more

players out there involved in helping the team be successful."

Spurrier announced Garcia's benching after Monday's practice. The fifth-year senior made the deci-

sion easy for Spurrier with his poor play the past few games. Garcia, who's started 34 games for Spurrier, threw four interceptions against Vanderbilt two weeks ago and added two more in a 16-13 loss last Saturday to Auburn, which entered ranked dead last in Southeastern Conference defense.

Spurrier said Shaw's work at practice the past few weeks has the staff thinking he's ready to shine. That won't be easy this week with Kentucky (2-3, 0-2 SEC), which has the SEC's fourth-best pass defense.

However, only Auburn has given up more points and yards on the ground in the SEC than Kentucky. And up next for the Wildcats defense is the league's leading rusher in South Carolina star Marcus Lattimore.

"I hope they shake it up and don't turn it over to 21 (Lattimore)," Kentucky coach Joker Phil-

lips said. "That's the shaking up I'd like to see done."

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Lattimore has run for 677 yards and nine touchdowns this season. But he was held to season lows with 66 yards and 17 carries as

Auburn crowded the line and forced the Gamecocks to beat the Tigers passing, something Garcia couldn't do.

SEC sacks leader Melvin Ingram could miss South Carolina's game with Kentucky because of a foot injury.

Spurrier said Tuesday that the defensive end was unlikely to practice this week and could sit out this weekend's game.

Ingram has 51/2 sacks, two interceptions and a fumble recovery through five games.

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




