In Cunningham's last rate case decided in 2009, the PSC found that Cunningham could justify a higher rate increase than it requested, but Cunningham declined the higher increase to reduce the burden upon its customers. Since then, Cunningham's costs have continued to increase. The proposed effective date of the change is <u>December 31, 2011</u>.
