ORDER

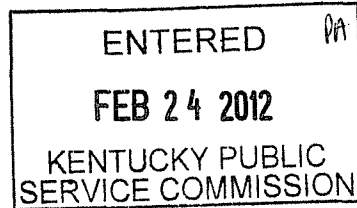
On February 13, 2011, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") filed with the Commission a petition for approval of a revised tariff to recover costs associated with its Demand-Side Management ("DSM") programs, including net lost revenues and program-related incentives. The application proposes that the DSM tariff become effective March 29, 2012. Based upon its initial review of Kentucky Power's proposed tariff, the Commission finds that additional inquiry is necessary to determine the tariff's reasonableness. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed DSM tariff for five months.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Kentucky Power's proposed DSM tariff is suspended for five months from its proposed effective date of March 29, 2012 up to and including August 28, 2012.

2. Kentucky Power's existing DSM programs and tariff shall remain in effect pending the Commission's Final Order in this proceeding.
