## APPLICATION

This Application of the Larue County Water District No. 1 ("Applicant") respectfully shows:

- 1. That Applicant is a water district created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

- 3. That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.020 and 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, permitting Applicant to construct a waterworks construction project, consisting of extensions, additions, and improvements (the "Project") to the existing waterworks system of Applicant; (ii) an Order approving increased rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.
- 4. The Project consists of the construction and installation of (i) approximately 10,500 linear feet of 6 inch waterline; (ii) 17,000 linear feet of 4 inch waterline; (iii) 8,000 linear feet of 3 inch waterline; (iv) a 50,000 gallon ground water storage tank with appurtenances; and (v) a 50,000 gallon elevated water storage tank with appurtenances.
- 5. That Applicant proposes to finance the construction of the Project through (i) the issuance of \$245,000 of its Waterworks Revenue Bonds, (ii) a USDA, Rural Development ("RD") grant in the amount of \$105,000, and (iii) four (4) Kentucky Infrastructure Authority ("KIA") grants in the aggregate amount of \$1,150,000. Applicant has a commitment from RD to purchase said \$245,000 of bonds maturing over a 40-year period, at an interest rate of not exceeding 3.25% per annum, as set out in the RD Letter of Conditions, as amended, filed herewith as an Exhibit.
