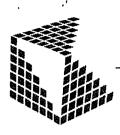

We have examined and reviewed both the costs and records of treating water at the North Plant of the Henderson Water Utility - Water and Sewer Commission for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. These figures are taken from the audited financial statements issued by our firm or from other audited information.

The purpose of these reviews was to determine whether cost increased during this period which would justify a rate increase to the Henderson County Water District. The tabulations of expenses for the North Water Treatment Plant are attached as part of this report.

Based on our review, we have determined that allowable expenses were \$4,227,153 and the gallons of water distributed amounted to 2,388,961,817 gallon units.

Therefore, the cost per 1,000 gallons is:

$$\frac{$4,227,153}{2,388,961,817}$$
 = \$1.7695 per 1,000 gallons

The cost indicated above, plus the markup of 25%, as allowed in the contract with the Henderson County Water District, would indicate that a rate of \$ 2.2118 per 1,000 gallons should be charged to the Henderson County Water District for the treatment of water for the period beginning March 1, 2012.

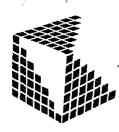

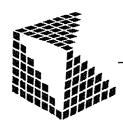

Due to an increase from its water supplier, Beech Grove Water System has filed an application with the Public Service Commission to increase its rates for water service. The utility has proposed an effective date of 4-1-2012.
