BES as a result of the EPA Cross-State Air Pollution Rule (CSAPR). The deliverable is a report focused on CSAPR impacts in 2012. The attached document gives a brief overview of the objectives, timeline, and write-up instructions.

The schedule is aggressive and the first milestone for us is to have responses to the questions in the impact study document and updated worksheet by 11/16.

TVA will compile all the responses for the Central subregion and submit to SERC on the specified date.

If you would please take the lead for BREC or provide me the name of someone who could, I would appreciate it. The questions will require input from several organizations internal to each company.

I do want to emphasize that the focus of the study is 2012, so provide answers with 2012 as the target year.
