PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

To the Commission:

The Elkhorn Water District respectfully requests that the Commission allow us to make an adjustment in our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustment Clause.

The District purchased 63,191,400 gallons from February 2011 to January 2012. The District sold 48,322,900 gallons to its customers. The effective cost of water purchased was 1.86 (with the Kentucky River Authority fee) during the test period. With the wholesale increase by the Frankfort Electric and Water Plant Board the new cost is expected to be 1.96 making the total new cost \$123,855.14. The difference between the old cost and the new cost is expected to be \$6,319.14; the incremented cost in terms of water sold is \$.13 per 1,000 gallons. We propose to raise each gallonage block that amount.
