PETITION FOR TRANSFER AND APPROVAL OF FINANCING

Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC (Frontier), by counsel, petitions for an order approving the transfer of the assets of the former B.T.U. Gas Company pursuant to KRS 278.020. This petition also requests approval of financing of the acquisitions pursuant to KRS 278.300.

In support of its petition the following information is provided.

- 1. Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC is a Colorado company authorized to do business in Kentucky. Its address is 4891 Independence St., Wheat Ridge CO 80033. Managing partners are Robert Oxford, Larry Rich and Steven Shute. A copy of its articles organization and its certificate to operate in Kentucky were filed in Case No. 2008-00394. A current Certificate of Existence is attached as exhibit 1. It owns and operates East Kentucky Gas (Floyd County Gas), Belfry Gas, Alert Gas Farm Tap System, Mike Little Gas Company pursuant to the order in Case No. 2008-00394 issued on November 25, 2008. It also owns the stock of Auxier Road Gas Company, which was approved in Case No. 2009-00442. It acquired the assets of Cow Creek Gas Company (formerly Sigma Gas Company) and Dema Gas Company in Case 2010-00076.
- 2. Frontier seeks approval of the transfer and financing of the assets of B.T.U. Gas Company (BTU). BTU is the subject of a Chapter 7 bankruptcy

proceeding in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of KY, Pikeville Division, Case No. 10-70767-TNA. The debtors, Richard Dow Williams and Pamela Jean Williams owned the stock and assets of BTU before transfer to the Bankruptcy Trustee. The Trustee is now in possession of the assets of BTU. As part of the bankruptcy proceedings, the assets were offered for sale at a public auction by the Bankruptcy Trustee. Frontier was the successful bidder for the assets and a Notice of Sale was entered by the Trustee on February 21, 2012. A copy of the Notice is attached as exhibit 2.

- 3. The purchase price of the assets is \$255,000. PSC approval of this acquisition is required by KRS 278.020 and by the Notice of Sale.
- 4. Under KRS 278.020(5), no person may acquire or transfer control of a utility until the Commission has determined that the acquirer has the financial, technical, and managerial abilities to provide reasonable service. In addition, under KRS 278.020(6), no individual may acquire control of a utility unless the Commission has determined that the acquisition is made in accordance with the law, for a proper purpose, and is consistent with the public interest.

The Commission has previously determined that a transfer is in the "public interest" if it does not adversely affect the existing level of utility service or rates or that any potentially adverse effects can be avoided through the Commission's imposition of reasonable conditions on the acquiring party.

5. KRS 278.020(4) provides that no person shall acquire or transfer ownership or control of a utility with Commission approval. KRS 278.010 defines person as natural persons, partnerships or corporations. Federal bankruptcy courts and trustees are not included in the definition of persons. Frontier believes that under the circumstances of this proceeding, it is the only applicant required to participate in this application. The Notice of Sale of the Trustee is evidence of his intent to dispose of the assets and is the only document required for Frontier to

proceed with this application.

BTU is not the seller of the assets and is not a party to this application. Its ability to dispose of the assets is restricted by the rules of the bankruptcy proceeding and it is not a participant in the transfer process. In a similar case involving the sale of bankrupt utility facilities, the acquiring utility was the only applicant. See Case No. 2007-00419, Application of DLR Enterprises to Acquire Sigma Gas Company.

- 6. The transfer will have no effect on the ability of Frontier to continue to operate or finance the operations of its natural gas service in Kentucky. Frontier's present management, office and field personnel will operate the facilities of the companies, with the addition of one field employee and one office employee. Frontier has adequate gas supply agreements to continue to purchase gas and to assure continued adequate supply. The transfers will have no impact on the current financial, managerial or technical ability of the company to operate. Frontier's operating procedures, personnel and management qualifications were included in Case No. 2008-00394 and are incorporated by reference.
- 7. No rate change is being requested at this time. Frontier proposes to adopt the currently approved General Rates and tariffs of BTU. Frontier anticipates these rates will stay in effect at least until the company consolidates the rates and operations of its other gas utilities. An adoption notice is attached as exhibit 3.
- 8. Frontier has the technical, managerial and financial ability to operate the company as reflected in its current Kentucky gas operations. It was most recently found to satisfy these requirements in Case No. 2010-0076. Its current financial activities are reflected on the attached financial operating statements exhibit 4.
 - 9. The transfer of the assets and customers is in accord with law, is in the

public interest and is for a proper purpose. Frontier asserts that the public interest standard is met by improved management and operational service by experienced, competent management and that the uncertainty that has surrounded the utility during the bankruptcy will finally be resolved. All customers will be metered and billed regularly at approved tariff rates. Free and unmetered service will be eliminated. Customers will have access to Frontier business and service personnel during regular business hours and for emergency purposes. Gas supply and pressure will meet Commission standards as will all safety standards. The financial stability of the company will be improved, which will allow for stable rates, access to capital for infrastructure repairs and extensions.

Given the history of BTU, the management, financial stability and technical experience of Frontier will be a significant improvement to the overall operations of the company and the service to the customers.

10. Frontier proposes to transfer the assets of BTU into the existing Cow Creek system on an interim basis. Frontier has found BTU to be a disconcerted jumble of lines that is not configured like a utility. There are about 68 miles of lines that have been located as being part of BTU versus 82 miles reported to PSC and US DOT by BTU previously. Some of these lines have contested ownership. These pipelines are mostly gathering in nature with scattered customers. There are a few distribution segments like Royalton with customer density more like a distribution system. There are miles of pipe with no customers and no strategic purpose. Frontier will roll all of these assets into Cow Creek Gas to establish service under an existing utility, but will retain the existing BTU Gas rates pending a consolidating rate case. A diagram of the location of customers identified to date and a pipeline inventory compiled by Frontier are attached as exhibit 5.

Frontier plans to consolidate Cow Creek with its other area utilities in 2012. At the time of consolidation, Frontier may propose to the Commission an alternative

plan for some BTU assets, including the sale of some lines as gathering lines to DLR Inc. or others. Frontier would continue to service customers as farm taps. Until there is more operating history with BTU, Frontier is not ready to make those distinctions.

- 11. Kentucky Frontier's is seeking a loan from Community Trust Bank of Pikeville, KY debt to acquire BTU. Frontier has proposed terms and supplied financial data to the bank to support the loan request. See exhibit 6. Approval of this financing is required b KRS 278.300. When the Bank approves the loan, the terms and conditions will be submitted to the Commission.
- 12. The proceeds of the financing will be used to acquire assets, facilities and customers reflected in the Notice of Sale.
- 13. The proceeds of the financing are not being used to refund any outstanding obligations.
- 14. Kentucky Frontier's business plan is generally reflected in the loan statements, description of proposed operations and other information provided in this application.
- 15. A description of the original cost of the BTU property to be acquired by Frontier can be found in the PSC Annual Reports, which are incorporated by reference. Frontier has no additional or more substantive information about the system cost of BTU. Most financial records of BTU are lost, destroyed or otherwise unavailable to Frontier. The cost to Kentucky Frontier of the property is described above.
 - 16. Kentucky Frontier is an LLC and has no stock.
 - 17. No stock is to be issued in conjunction with this financing.
- 18. The proposed debt to be issued, amount, interest rate and security are described in exhibit 6.
 - 19. The proceeds of the financing are not being used to refund any

outstanding obligations.

- 20. There is no preferred stock issued.
- 21. There are no mortgages.
- 22. There are no bonds issued or to be issued by Kentucky Frontier.
- 23. Notes are described in exhibit 4.
- 24. There are no other debts.
- 25. No dividends have been paid by Kentucky Frontier in the last five years.
 - 26. A balance sheet and income statement is attached as exhibit 4.
 - 27. USoA accounts and journal entries will be provided after closing.

Frontier has the financial, technical and managerial ability to continue to operate these facilities. It is in the public interest for this transfer of assets, customers and facilities and related financing to be approved.

For these reasons, Frontier requests that the transfer be approved pursuant to KRS 278.020 and the financing be approved pursuant to KRS 278.300.







The sale is subject to approval by the Kentucky Public Service Commission.



BTU Gas System Purchase

Dear Terry:

In phone conferences with you and Steve Belcher we discussed the feasibility of a loan with CTBI, perhaps through the SBA, for the purchase of the assets of BTU Gas Company. Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC is the successful bidder, by order of the bankruptcy court, for the purchase of BTU's assets. Frontier is in the process of filing an application with the Kentucky PSC for approval of the transfer of the utility to Frontier. As a part of the application we need a loan commitment letter for the portion of the acquisition that we want to finance.

Therefore, Frontier requests a commitment letter from CTBI which will contain the following:

1. Loan amount of \$250,000 for the purchase of BTU assets. (Frontier's bid was \$255,000. A payment of \$25,500 was made by Frontier to the bankruptcy trustee on February 17, 2012. Frontier has operated the system since August 15, 2011 under a Service Agreement with the trustee. Frontier has invoiced the trustee for over \$200,000 through February 29, 2012 for actual operating costs, including gas purchases from gas producers. The trustee will pay Frontier \$25,500 toward the invoiced amount, but has no other funds available until the closing on the sale of assets. Frontier expects the total amount billed for services will be between \$255,000 and \$300,000 by June 1. BTU's assets consist of over 70 miles of 1" to 4" pipe and over 500 customers. Frontier's valuation guideline of \$1000 per customer indicates a value of \$500,000.)

BTU annual sales volume has been, and is projected to continue at or above 35,000 MCF. The current approved tariff for BTU provides for a margin of \$3.90 for the first MCF, and \$2.97 per MCF for addition volumes each month. This projects to annual gross revenue of \$110,000. This is incremental income added to Frontier's current operations. Frontier will add two employees (technician and office clerk), one vehicle, and expenses for billing and other incidentals such as postage for 500 bills, which will total \$79,000 per year.

- 1, Current financials for each Frontier member, signed and dated.
- 2. Personal Income Tax returns for 2010, signed and dated.
- 3. Frontier Income Tax returns for 2010, signed and dated.
- 2. Frontier Balance Sheet and P&L for 2011, signed and dated.
- 3. Frontier debt schedule.

Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC was formed in Colorado in 2005, by its members, Steven E. Shute (40%), Robert J. Oxford (30%), Larry J. Rich (20%), and Industrial Gas Services, Inc. (10%). Frontier acquired, effective December 1, 2008, 100% ownership in the Floyd County Gas system (aka East Kentucky Utilities), Mike Little Gas Company, Belfry Gas system, and the farm taps of Kinzer Drilling Company and Alert Gas and Oil Company. Frontier has operated the gas systems of these companies and served their former residential and commercial customers, numbering over 2000, for over three years.

Frontier acquired Auxier Road Gas Company, Cow Creek Gas Company, Dema Gas Company, and Farm Taps from Interstate Gas Company in early 2010. In January 2010, Frontier moved into ARGC's office building and shop under a lease from Sallye Branham at the market rate of \$18,000 per year. Total customers presently number over 3500.

Frontier projects a net profit of over \$200,000 through December, 2012 on gross revenue of over \$1,500,000. Customer stability is strong, with the usual dip in numbers during the summer and the usual reconnections in the fall. Frontier now has seven full time technicians and an office staff of four. Frontier's hourly wages for technicians, administrators, clerks are above average. The company personnel handbook outlines the benefits provided to employees. The Memberowners provide management for the company and have a four bedroom townhouse in Stone Crest that provides lodging and executive offices for them in Prestonsburg.

Frontier purchases its gas from Quality Gas (a Kinzer company), Cumberland Valley, NYTIS, and Columbia. BTU gas supply comes from local producers in Magoffin County. The Kentucky Public Service Company allows gas distributors to pass through to their customers the actual cost of gas from their suppliers. Gas costs are adjusted quarterly.

Please furnish us with a loan commitment letter as soon as possible so that we can file our application with the KPSC. Thank you for you assistance and continued support.
