ORDER

On November 23, 2011, West Laurel Water Association ("West Laurel") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- West Laurel purchases water from Wood Creek Water District ("Wood Creek").
- 2. On November 18, 2011, Wood Creek increased its wholesale water rate to West Laurel from \$2.32 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.92 per 1,000 gallons.²
- 3. West Laurel proposes to increase its rates for water service effective December 22, 2011.
- 4. During the 12 months ending October 31, 2011, West Laurel purchased a total of 359,299,800 gallons of water and sold 258,130,800 gallons. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$215,579.88, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$0.84 per 1,000 gallons.

- 5. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.84 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
 - 6. West Laurel's proposed rates are fair, just, and reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.84 per 1,000 gallons as calculated in Appendix A is approved.
- 2. West Laurel's proposed rates, which are set forth in Appendix B, are approved for service rendered on or after December 22, 2011.
 - 3. The tariff sheets filed by West Laurel are approved as filed.

Corporate Resolution

Be it hereby resolved, by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors of the Cumberland Falls Highway Water District (herein referred to as "CFHWD" at a regular called meeting on February 21, 2012, as follows:

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:068, the Cumberland Falls Highway Water District hereby approves a Purchased Water Adjustment rate increase of \$0.28 per 1,000 gallons, effective March 22, 2012, to compensate for the increase in the base rate of water sold to the CFHWD by the West Laurel Water Association Incorporated (WLWAI) from \$3.62 per 1,000 gallons (base rate) to \$4.46 per 1,000 gallons (changed rate) which became effective on December 22, 2011 per PSC order in Case No. 2011-00457 and the Williamsburg rate from \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons (base rate) to \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons (changed rate) per the attached letter. This increase is adopted in order for the CFHWD to recover the actual cost of water purchased from the WLWAI.
