RESPONSE OF BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION
TO MOTION OF KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL
UTILITY CUSTOMERS, INC. TO AMEND PROCEDURAL ORDER

The Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered a procedural order in this case on April 4, 2012. The last event scheduled on the procedural order was the filing by Big Rivers of responses to supplemental requests for information, which are due and will be filed today, May 11, 2012.

Intervenor Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") filed a motion on May 10, 2012, seeking an amendment to the procedural schedule to allow KIUC "to file testimony or comments no later than May 18, 2012." The KIUC motion includes a sentence that: "It is KIUC's present intention to file written comments in lieu of testimony."

Big Rivers requested in its application that the Commission enter an order in this matter no later than May 25, 2012, to allow sufficient time for expiration of the statutory period for appeal of the order prior to the scheduled closing date for the proposed financing transactions, which is June 29, 2012.

Meeting the scheduled closing date is very important to Big Rivers. As stated in Big Rivers' application and data request responses, Big Rivers needs to capture

the cost savings anticipated from the proposed borrowings. And because the Treasury rates on which the rates for the two term loans proposed by Big Rivers will be based have been trending downward recently, there is an opportunity for greater savings than were anticipated in Big Rivers' application.

In reliance upon the statement by KIUC that its present intention is to file written comments in lieu of testimony, a statement which KIUC counsel verbally confirmed to Big Rivers counsel yesterday, Big Rivers does not object to the KIUC motion to amend the procedural schedule. But Big Rivers does reserve the right to respond promptly to the KIUC comments if Big Rivers considers a response necessary under the circumstances to protect the relief it is seeking, or the scheduled closing date.
