KENTUCKY-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DATA RESPONSES

Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky American") respectfully requests the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to issue an order granting Kentucky American through and until August 3, 2012, to file their responses to the Commission's Data Requests issued on July 12, 2012. In support of this Motion, Kentucky American states as follows:

On July 12, 2012, the Commission issued an order denying Kentucky American's Request for Termination of Case and attached data requests to that order, which are due on July While the number of requests is not voluminous, additional time is needed for 26, 2012. Kentucky American to respond to the requests. The response period in this proceeding overlapped significantly with the response period in Case No. 2012-00096, In the Matter of: Application of Kentucky-American Water Company for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Authorizing Construction of the Northern Division Connection, in which Kentucky American had to respond to over 100 data requests (not including subparts) issued by the Commission and the Attorney General. Also, one of Kentucky American's employees who is critical to preparing the responses has had very limited availability due to preexisting commitments since the requests were issued.

The Commission's July 12, 2012 order provided each party with 21 days to request a hearing or the case would otherwise be submitted for decision. WHEREFORE, Kentucky American Water Company respectfully requests that it be granted an extension to respond to the Commission's data requests through and until August 3, 2012, and that the parties have through and until August 10, 2012, to request a hearing, or the case will be submitted for decision.
