On Tuesday December 6th, I responded to the above locations and observed the scene and made the following notations concerning operations to shut the gas off to the involved area and determine the location of the leak. From interviews conducted at the scene, the following time line was created.


0416 Text message to LGE worker
0445 Gas trouble man arrives on the scene
0533 BUD contacted
0652 Construction crew arrives
0752 Crew starting hole in front yard of 5131 Queens Castle Road
0756 Beginning hole at end of the street
0757 Fire department reports high readings in the 5200 block of River Trail Place. Starting evacuations
0800 Noticed that third crew had begun digging hole at 5210 River Trail Place
0802 Another hole started at 5202 River Trail Place
0804 LGE crew beginning to attach clamp at 5131Queens Castle
0806 LGE crew beginning to attach clamp at 5210 River Trial Place
0807 Clamp at 5131 River Trial installed
0809 Clamp installed at 5210 River Trail
0820 Beginning clamping at 5202 River Trial Place
0820 Clamp installed at 5202 River Trial Place
0823 Gas flow reduced 99% at manhole and storm catch basin
1211 Gas line at meter at 5207 River Trail Place tested positive for the presence of chlorine
1225 MSD reports their lines are clear of any natural gas
1401 Street supply gas line at 5202 River Trail tested positive for chlorine
1404 No leak in water line at 5133 Queens Castle
1425 Determined area of leak at 5133 Queens Castle.




