Notice is hereby given that the Graves County Water District seeks approval by the Public Service Commission, Frankfort, Kentucky, for an adjustment of rates. Graves County proposes a total revenue requirement of \$1,180,954, which is an increase of \$215,409, approximately 22.3 percent. Graves County Water District is proposing to phase in the requested increase in two phases. The initial phase will produce annual operating revenues from water sales of \$1,048,259, an increase of \$145,526 or approximately 16.1 percent over normalized revenues from water sales of \$902,733. The Phase II rate increase will produce annual operating revenues from water sales of \$1,118,142, an increase of \$69,883 or approximately 6.67 percent over normalized revenues from the phase I increase of \$1,048,259. Graves County Water District is requesting the Phase I rates be effective upon Public Service Commission approval and the Phrase II rates to become effective when payback of KIA loan for the AMI meter project starts.
