Session 1: Boil Water Advisories

Presenter: Randall Kelley, Kentucky Rural Water Association

This session will provide two (2) hours of training and will focus on Boil Water Advisories. There is considerable confusion on when boil water advisories are required and when they aren't. Some utilities rarely issue them, others seem to issue them for practically any reason. Topics will include:

- 1. What is a boil water advisory?
- 2. When a boil water advisory should be used, and when one is it not necessary.
- 3. Line break requirements versus emergency repairs.
- 4. Lifting boil water advisories.
