- Q-1. In reference to the Response to Information Requested in Appendix of Commission's Order Dated August 22, 2012, Question No. 24, does the federal EPA issue advisory opinions to help utilities determine whether certain generation efficiency efforts could trigger a New Source Review?
- Facility owners and operators assessing the potential application of New Source Review A-1. (NSR) requirements to particular projects typically rely on an existing body of judicial precedent, EPA policy memoranda and agency guidance regarding how NSR applies to certain factual situations. Upon request, the Kentucky Division for Air Quality or the US EPA will issue Applicability Determinations addressing the applicability of New Source Review (NSR) requirements to particular projects. However, obtaining such an Applicability Determination is not common practice for the Company or in the industry, due primarily to the time required (up to a year or more) to complete the process and receive a final agency determination. The process for obtaining such Applicability Determinations requires submittal of detailed information on the project, including the nature, purpose and cost, historic operations at the unit, any projected emissions caused by the project (after removal of any emissions increases attributable to factors unrelated to the project), and any possible "netting" through emissions reductions from other units at the facility. Due to the time constraints typically associated with the company's projects and ongoing engineering changes that are frequently incorporated as project design is finalized, the Company has generally found obtaining Applicability Determinations to be impractical. For projects such as planned generation efficiency projects, the Company generally relies on general EPA guidance documents and relevant judicial decisions in the NSR area, as well as its own experience regarding EPA's and KDAQ's treatment of similar projects, to conduct any necessary analyses and to determine whether NSR requirements may be implicated.
