## NOTICE

The Jackson County Water Association has filed a proposed rate schedule with the Public Service Commission which will increase the rate for wholesale water service provided as follows:

The proposed effective date is August 1, 2011.

Water passing through the meter on and after that date will be billed at \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons. At an average monthly usage of 500,000 gallons and 37.2% rate increase, this will amount to an approximate \$475 per month increase in water costs.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Jackson County Water Association. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rate contained in this notice that may be higher or lower than proposed.

RE: Wholesale Water Rates

Dear Mr. Whitaker;

The City of Mt. Vernon is currently undertaking a \$2,600,000 project to improve its water storage system. The project is being funded through a loan from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF). The conditions of the loan stipulated that the City would be required to raise its rates to generate the revenue needed for the proper operation, maintenance, and financing of the project. A rate increase of 36.00% was uniformly applied to all of the City's retail and wholesale water rates.

The City will be petitioning the Public Service Commission (PSC) to increase the wholesale rate to the Western Rockcastle Water Association, Inc. from \$2.16 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.93 per 1,000 gallons. The increased rate is based on a cost of service study prepared by Carlos F. Miller, P.E. with Kenvirons, Inc.

To expedite the PSC's approval of the new wholesale rate, we are requesting that you execute the attached amendment to the Water Purchase Agreement and return it to our office in a timely manner.

Be it hereby resolved, by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors of the Eastern Rockcastle Water Association (herein referred to as "ERWA") at a regular called meeting on November 19, 2012, as follows:

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5068, the Eastern Rockcastle Water Association hereby approves a Purchased Water Adjustment rate increase of \$0.91 per 1000 gallons, effective November 10, 2012 and will be reflected in the January 2013 billing cycle, to compensate for the increase in the base rate of water sold to the ERWA by the Jackson County Water Association from \$2.66 per 1000 gallons (base rate) to \$3.50 per 1000 gallons (changed rate) which became effective on August 1, 2012 per the Jackson County Water Association's notification dated June 21, 2012; City of Mt. Vernon from \$2.16 per 1000 gallons (base rate) to \$2.93 per 1000 gallons (changed rate) which became effective on August 17, 2012 per the Kentucky Public Service Commission's notification on July 30, 2012; and City of Livingston from \$2.55 per 1000 gallons (base rate) to \$3.19 per 1000 gallons (changed rate) which became effective on July 1, 2012 per the City of Livingston's notification dated May 18, 2012.
