SALT RIVER ELECTRIC RESPONSES TO COMMISSION STAFF'S AMENDED SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE INC.'S SIXTEEN MEMBER DISTRIBUTION COOPERATIVES

The undersigned, Larry Hicks, President and CEO of Salt River Electric Cooperative Corporation, being duly sworn, responds to requests for information herein as follows:

Request No. 1:

Refer to EKPC'S responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information, Item 2, and respond to the following:

a. Have you experienced any problems in administering the refund of any over-recovery or collection of any under-recovery of environmental surcharge costs?

Response: Salt River Electric has had no problems administering any over-recovery or collection of environmental surcharge costs.

> b. Do you recommend any changes from the current method of refunding/collecting any over- or under-recovery of environmental surcharge costs over a six-month time period? If so what is the time period you believe is appropriate?

Response: Salt River Electric recommends no change from the current six-month time period of refunding/collecting any over- or under-recovery of environmental surcharge costs.

> c. Describe the benefits, if any, of allowing the refund/collection of any over- or under-recovery of environmental surcharge costs to be spread over a time period different from the current six-month recovery period.

Response: If the amount of the recovery of environmental surcharge costs is an underrecovery, it could reduce the amount the consumer would pay per month in addition to the normal surcharge that would be billed.

> d. Describe the negative effect, if any, of allowing the refund/collection of over- or under-recovery of environmental surcharge costs to be spread over a time period different from the current six-month period.

Response: If the amount of the recovery of environmental surcharge cost is an overrecovery, it would take six months longer for the consumer to get back the recovery amount.

Request No. 2:

Provide the member cooperative's actual average residential customer's monthly kWh usage. Based on this usage amount, provide the dollar impact any over- or under-recovery will have on the average residential customer's bill for a recovery period of six months and a recovery period of 12 months.

Response: Salt River Electric's average residential customer's average monthly kWh usage for 2012 is 1,273. Using this average kWh, a customer's monthly bill would be \$110.07 based on our current tariffs. Using the calculated environmental surcharge from Exhibit 1 (attached), the yearly billed environmental surcharge would be \$156.65 for 2012. Using the calculated environmental surcharge from Exhibit 2 (attached), and doing a six-month recovery from June to December for a \$698,660 over-recovery, the yearly billed environmental surcharge would be \$145.87 for 2012. Using the calculated environmental surcharge from Exhibit 3 (attached), and doing a 12month recovery from January to December for the same \$698,660 overrecovery, the yearly billed environmental surcharge would be \$145.92 for 2012. This comparison can be found in Schedule A (attached). Based on the information in Schedule A, the difference between a six-month recovery and a 12-month recovery results in the customer paying \$.05 more using a 12month recovery than a six-month recovery period.
