Response 1c: In an <u>over-recovery</u> of the environmental surcharge, the shorter the recovery time the quicker the customer will benefit.

In an <u>under-recovery</u>, the cooperative will be short in cash resulting possibly in shortterm borrowing and the customer will have to pay a higher amount as the recovery time is shortened.

d. Describe the negative effects, if any, of allowing the refund/collection of over- and underrecovery of environmental surcharge costs to be spread over a time period different from the current six-month period.

Reponse 1d: As in response to 1c. depending on whether it is an over or under recovery and the length of recovery time depends on what perspective you are reviewing from. Sometimes it benefits the customer and negatively affects the cooperative and vice versa.
