ORDER

Middletown Waste Disposal, Inc. ("Middletown Waste") has requested a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), which requires the filing of a financial exhibit covering "operations for a twelve (12) month period . . . ending not more than ninety (90) days prior to the date the application is filed."¹ It has provided its financial statements for calendar year 2011 and represents that there has been no change that is material in nature in its financial condition or operation since the publication of these statements.

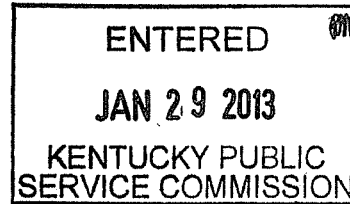
Finding that Middletown Waste has demonstrated good cause to permit its deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Middletown Waste's motion to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), is granted.
2. Middletown Waste's application is considered filed as of the date of this Order.


¹ 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), refers to Section 12. At the time of Middletown Waste's initial submission, this requirement was found at 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11. The Commission recently amended 807 KAR 5:001. As a result of this amendment, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11, is now 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17.

3. Nothing contained in this Order shall preclude the Commission from requiring the production of information regarding Middletown Waste's financial condition or operations since December 31, 2011.
