Joint Motion To Suspend August 27, 2014 Procedural Schedule

Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Brandenburg Telephone
Company, Inc., Duo County Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Foothills Rural
Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Gearheart Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a
Coalfields Telephone Company, Highland Telephone Cooperative, Inc., Logan Telephone
Cooperative, Inc., Mountain Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., North Central
Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Peoples Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc.
South Central Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Thacker-Grigsby Telephone
Company, Inc., West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation., Inc. d/b/a WK&T,
South Central Telcom LLC, Cumberland Cellular, Inc., d/b/a Duo County Telecom, North
Central Communications, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Kentucky ("AT&T

Kentucky"), and AT&T Corp. (collectively the "Movants") jointly and respectfully move the Public Service Commission of Kentucky to suspend the August 27, 2014 Procedural Order entered by the Commission in Case No. 2011-00199. In support of their Joint Motion the Movants state:

- 1. On October 9, 2014 the Movants entered into a Settlement Agreement that, *inter alia*, settles five actions¹ currently pending before the Commission. Among the proceedings that are resolved by the October 9, 2014 Settlement Agreement is Case No. 2011-00199.
- 2. On October 10, 2014 the Movants filed the Settlement Agreement with the Commission, requested the Commission approve the agreement, and requested that upon such approval, the Commission dismiss the five actions that are the subject of the Settlement Agreement.
- 3. The Commission's August 27, 2014 Order in Case No. 2011-00199 requires that the Movants on or before November 17, 2014 file "initial requests for information" and respond to initial requests for information previously filed.
- 4. The Settlement Agreement, if approved, moots the need for the discovery in Case No. 2011-00199 (as well as the other four proceedings that are the subject of the Settlement Agreement).
- 5. The previously filed requests for information will require substantial time, expense, and other resources to be expended by the Movants to answer. Given the scope of the information sought, and the additional deadlines imposed by the August 27, 2014 order, the

Movants cannot await a ruling on their motion to approve the Settlement Agreement to begin responding to the discovery requests. Requiring the Movants to undertake such effort and expense in light of their proposed settlement would be, respectfully, unreasonable. Moreover, to the extent the Movants disagree concerning the relevancy to the proceedings of the information sought by the pending discovery, or the Movants have other objections to the pending discovery requests, or the Movants seek confidential treatment for information that otherwise would be produced in response to the pending discovery requests, the Commission would be needlessly required to expend its scare resources.

WHEREFORE, the Movants respectfully and jointly request that the Public Service Commission of Kentucky enter an Order:

- (a) Suspending the Commission's August 27, 2014 Order establishing a procedural schedule in Case No. 2011-00199 pending the Commission's approval of the Settlement Agreement; and
 - (b) Granting the Movants all further relief to which they may appear entitled.
