BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION'S MOTION FOR DEVIATION

1. Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for a deviation from the requirement in 807 KAR 5:001 Section 9(2)(b). As grounds for its motion, Big Rivers states the following.

2. On or about June 6, 2013, Big Rivers requested that the Kentucky Press Service have notice of the hearing in this matter published in a newspaper of general circulation in each of the counties in Big Rivers' service territory. The notice was published in a newspaper of general circulation in each county at least seven (7) and not more than twenty-one (21) days prior to the hearing, except that the notice was published in the Union County Advocate only five (5) days prior to the hearing. The Union County Advocate is the newspaper of general circulation for Union County.

3. Kentucky Press Service first scheduled the publication with the Union County Advocate, which is a weekly paper published on Wednesdays, for June 12, 2013 (19 days prior to the hearing), and the Union county Advocate signed off on the publication. However, the notice was not published in the June 12 edition. Kentucky Press Service then scheduled the publication with the Union County Advocate for June 19, 2013 (12 days prior to the hearing), and the Union County Advocate signed off on the publication. However, the notice was not published in the June 19 edition. The next available publication was the June 26 edition (5 days

prior to the hearing), and the notice did get published in that edition. The Kentucky Press Service and the Union County Advocate have provided letters evidencing the above and proof of publication to the Commission.


4. Notice was also published in the Henderson Gleaner and the Marion Crittenden Press, at least seven (7) and not more than twenty-one (21) days prior to the hearing. Both of those papers have circulation in Union County.

5. Based on the foregoing, Big Rivers requests that the Commission grant it a deviation from the requirement in 807 KAR 5:001 Section 9(2)(b) that Big Rivers publish notice of the hearing at least seven (7) and not more than twenty-one (21) days prior to the hearing, and find that Big Rivers was in substantial compliance with the publication requirement.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Big Rivers respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001 Section 9(2)(b) and find that Big Rivers was in substantial compliance with the publication requirement.
