Please be advised that the Salyersville Water Works Commission has negotiated a wholesale water rate increase effective January 10, 2013. Magoffin County Water District intends to pass this increase through to our retail customers in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068. This rate adjustment was approved by the District Commissioners during the December 13, 2012 board meeting.

Magoffin County respectfully requests a deviation to shorten the notice period from the standard thirty (30) days to a period not less than twenty (20) days as provided for in KRS 278.180 in order to meet the agreed upon effective date.
