As a resident of Old Bridge Subdivision in Danville Ky., please let this letter serve as my objection to the request of AmeriGas to discontinue their bulk service to our neighborhood.

The system they have in place has served us well from its inception. When the subdivision was originally developed, a bulk system was installed to avoid having numerous fuel tanks scattered about the neighborhood. In fact, we have **deed restrictions** forbidding fuel tanks above or below ground. The original propane provider went to great expense to install this system, and the property owners have upheld their end of the agreement by using the system in place.

I don't think AmeriGas has considered the long range outcome of their request. I would venture to say if they are successful, that every property owner that must install a tank, will use anybody **except** AmeriGas, out of spite. Additionally, older homes that have systems to be replaced in the coming years, will likely convert to electricity to avoid installing a tank.

Also, every home here has a septic system. Trying to bury tanks on these properties will provide many challenges.

As the **Public** Service Commission, I hope you will give due consideration to our request to deny AmeriGas their request, and prevent us from having to deal with all of the issues that would occur.
