cooperatives. For your particular distribution cooperative, provide the actual average

customers monthly usage. Based on this usage amount, provide the dollar impact any

over- or under-recovery will have on the average residential customer's monthly bill for

the requested recovery period. Provide all supporting calculations.

Response:

Using billing data for December, 2012, \$135.45 is the average residential 7.

monthly bill when no over-or under-recovery amount is included. When the over- or

under-recovery is included in the calculation for the same period of time, \$135.92 is the

monthly bill. This results in a dollar impact of \$0.48 to the customer.
