Request of Richardsville Gas Company, Inc. to Abandon Facility

Pursuant to KRS 278.021, Section 2(b)

Pursuant to a Commission Staff notice dated October 15, 2013, an informal conference ("IC") was held in this matter on November 6, 2013. A memorandum on the IC was entered into the record of this case on November 12, 2013.

During the IC, the president and vice-president of Richardsville Gas Company, Inc. ("Richardsville"), Glenn Miller and Joan Miller, provided Commission Staff ("Staff") with copies of a schedule listing various expenses incurred by Richardsville in 2011, 2012, and 2013. The Millers also informed Staff that, in addition to the petition filed in this case and signed by many of their customers indicating the customers were willing to pay higher rates if the gas system were not abandoned, they had received a petition signed by the members of one of the churches served by Richardsville indicating their interest in helping to keep the utility operating.

On December 18, 2013, Staff members Matt Baer and Jeff Shaw performed a limited on-site review of Richardsville's billing records and made inquiry regarding some of the expense items included in the schedule provided to Staff during the November 6, 2103 IC (the handwritten notes on the schedule are Mrs. Miller's and were there when the it was provided at the IC). Staff members Baer and Shaw were also provided a copy of the petition signed by the church members that was discussed at the IC (from the Richardsville Church of Christ). So that the schedule and petition, documents the Millers have discussed with, and provided copies to, the Staff, are made part of the official record of this case, copies attached hereto are being filed in the case record.
