ORDER

On July 10, 2013, Pro Man Property Management, Inc. ("Pro Man") filed a request for a deviation from 807 KAR 5:071, Section 7(4), which requires, among other things, daily inspections of sewage treatment facility mechanical equipment. Commission Staff filed two requests for information in this matter on October 21, 2013, and January 30, 2014, respectively. Pro Man responded to Commission Staff's initial request for information on November 1, 2013. On February 17, 2014, Pro Man filed with the Commission a motion for leave to withdraw the request for deviation it filed on July 10, 2013.

In support of its motion, Pro Man states that after reviewing the material contained in Commission Staff's second request for information, it became aware that daily inspections of mechanical equipment could be performed by someone other than a certified operator. In light of this and other information, Pro Man seeks to withdraw its request for deviation from the requirement that sewage treatment facility mechanical equipment be inspected daily.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Pro Man has established good cause to permit it leave to withdraw its request for deviation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Pro Man's motion for leave to withdraw its July 10, 2013 application for a deviation is granted.
- 2. This case is dismissed without prejudice and removed from the Commission's docket.
